While here on the Sunny Coast we would love to share with you our beautiful, relaxing sub-tropical surrounds just 100 kilometres north of Brisbane. In spring 2024 on the Sunshine Coast, we would anticipate temperatures with a minimum of 13 to 24 degrees Celsius maximum (55 and 76 Fahrenheit respectively).

Local sights and experiences we recommend that you might include in your itinerary are:

- 100 kilometres of pure white sandy beaches (rated as some of the best in the world), headlands and outstanding coastal highlights,
- flight to nearby Fraser Coast,
- outstanding views of the coast and the ancient Glasshouse Mountains (26 million years old) from our Blackall Range,
- short easy walk-through Mary Caincross Scenic Reserve sub-tropical rain forest and adjacent views of the Glasshouse Mountains,
- whale-watching especially the southern migration of humpback whales with calves in tow,
- sample ginger at the internationally renowned Buderim Ginger factory complex at Yandina,
- our unique Eumundi markets,
- Kenliworth Cheese Factory,
- Caloundra Regional Gallery and/or Queensland Air Museum, and award winning restaurants especially with an emphasis on locally grown produce and seafood.

Our recommended schedule is as follows:

- a) Wednesday 11th September - arrival from Brisbane/Toowoomba, at the Maroochy Bushland Botanical Gardens where you will meet your hosts with refreshments and facilities available.
- b) Wednesday night – free to spend with your host.
- c) Thursday 12th September – your choice of activity,
- d) Thursday evening – dinner at a local Surf Club,
- e) Friday 13th September – your choice of activity,
- f) Friday night – fish n’ chips at Mooloolaba beach,
- g) Saturday morning 14th September – breakfast with the Prior before departure for return to Brisbane.

Delegates and partners costs will include travel to and from the Sunshine Coast. Lunch, dinner and excursions are at the delegates costs.

Hosting is limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. A range of alternate accommodation is available in the central part of the Sunshine Coast.
